

# TECHNIQUE: SHAVING CREAM



## MATERIALS

DB37473 Honeycomb Salad Plate Shaving Cream Brush Handle or Skewer Paper Plate

#### COLORS

CMM 14 - Gum Drop CMM 45 - Indigo CMM 2 - Stonewash CMM 57 - Squash Blossom

#### INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. This technique starts on a bare piece of pottery, so don't paint the background.
- 2. Place your paper plate on the table and cover it with a thick layer of shaving cream. We found it best to add more to the center making a little mountain.
- 3. Pour streams of all your paints directly onto the shaving cream. Repeat with the other colors.
- 4. Use the handle of your brush or a skewer to swirl the colors around through the shaving cream giving it a marbled look.
- 5. Gently place your pottery into the painted shaving cream until covered (you won't be able to get it on the inside of a piece).
- 6. Allow to dry for a couple of minutes before rinsing. GENTLY rinse off your shaving cream with with water from the sink. Heavy pressure will remove the paint as well as the shaving cream so rinse gently.

### TIPS

- We suggest using medium to dark colors for this technique.
- This makes a mess but it's fun!
- Be careful with the water pressure when you're rinsing so that you don't rinse off the paint.
